Rules and Regulations

1. Setup complete and ready to vend at 9:30am on the day of the festival. Vendors are responsible for their own setup and tear down, although volunteers may be available to help you load in/out. All booth spaces must be occupied until at least 5pm and be vacated by 7pm.
2. Specific setup areas will be assigned for merchandise vendors & organizations. Readers will be allowed to set up within the park where they desire as long as they are not blocking another vendor or the stage area. Requests for particular areas for special needs will be reviewed, and will take priority over other requests; nothing is guaranteed.
3. The Pagan Pride Day schedule, all important contacts, and a map of the Pagan Pride Day area will be provided to all vendors within three days of the event.
4. No sexually explicit or dangerous items can be in view of the public; however, items can be kept hidden from view and produced once someone has inquired about them. Signs indicating adult items may be placed on the table. Please ask if you have questions.
5. Vendors who would like to offer demonstrations of their products are asked to include a separate page description so we can review and add it to the event's schedule. Offering a short demonstration at your booth can draw in more traffic.
6. Any vendors engaging in any illegal activity, consumption of illegal drugs, or harassment of people will be asked to leave or escorted from property.
7. No refunds after September 23, 2022. Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the e-mail address listed below (no phone calls).
8. This year the city of New Orleans has issued a tax bond, all vendors must pay their taxes no more than 10 days after event. Failure to do so will incur a penalty of 500\$ per vendor charged to GNOPP nonprofit. Any vendor who fails to pay their taxes on time will be red listed from all future events, so please pay your taxes within 10 days.
9. Vendors must contact Dept of Revenue, revenue.vendorpermits@nola.gov. Any vendor who does not hold a current special event occupational license must purchase one for 50\$ valid through December, 31 2024. Available @ room 115 city hall. Cashiers check or money order only.
